

JOURNAL AUTHOR GUIDELINES



Please use these guidelines to ensure that your manuscript is complete prior to submission.

If you have any queries, please get in touch with your contact person at River Publishers.

Each paper submitted are reviewed to ensure quality, technical accuracy, and maximum interest to our readers. They will also be checked for plagiarism.

All papers submitted should:

- Clearly relate to the aims and scope of the journal (this is the most common reason for rejection)
- Justify all claims with evidence and without exaggeration
- Should be written in clear, concise and readable English (this is the second most common reason for rejection)

FORMAT OF SUBMITTED PAPER

- Please **use the style file, from our website.**
- Please include **all figures and tables within your paper**
- References should follow the **APA style of referencing**
- All **images** must be submitted with a **resolution of at least 500dpi**. *Scanned figures are not acceptable.*

FILES TO UPLOAD

1. **Article** - your paper including a minimum of 4 keywords in the format detailed above.
2. **Supplementary information** – if applicable, for example dataset, questionnaires

Further considerations

- Make sure your paper has been 'spell checked' and 'grammar checked'.
- Ensure all references mentioned in Reference List are cited in the text, and *vice versa*.
- Ensure permission has been obtained for use of copyrighted material from other sources (including the Internet) and state the relevant creative commons license for open access materials.
- Ensure all figure and table citations in the text match the files provided.

STRUCTURE OF YOUR ARTICLE

Title of paper

Titles are limited to *80 characters, including spaces*. Titles should clearly reflect the content of the manuscript.

Abstract

Please provide a maximum 300-word summary of the paper. This should be a concise reflection of the aims, conclusions and include interesting or important results. In particular, please specify the articles' relevance to the journal.

List of notations and abbreviations

Please provide a list of symbols, abbreviations and definitions used in the text.

Keywords

Please supply at least 4 keywords that may be used for indexing.

Appendices

Additional information, such as tables or mathematical calculations/derivations can be included and should be clearly referred to, from the main text, as belonging to the appendix.

Acknowledgements

Please provide details from those individuals and institutions that contributed to the paper. For example:

This research received no external funding

This research was funded by NAME OF FUNDER, grant number XXX.

The APC was funded by XXX

Ethics

Any associated safety, environmental or ethical issues should be declared and stated in the submission form and manuscript. A statement concerning any conflicts of interest should be included.

Mathematical equations

Only relevant equations should be included in the main text and should be numbered – anything else can be added as an appendix or as supplementary information.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR MANUSCRIPT

Manuscripts and other files should be uploaded to River Publishers' Journal submission platform. Emailed documents are not accepted. Please go to the journal website to submit your paper.
