All proceedings are published as open access and submitted to Scopus for indexing. Please contact River Publishers for pricing information.

For all proposals, please use the River Publishers book proposal form, available in both [MS Word](#).

In particular, to review the proposal we require:

1. Conference website
2. Policy for the reviewing
3. Organizing committee
4. Number of papers

Guidelines for the proceedings and other details can be followed [here](#). Articles need to follow a standard template; our preference is that these are provided to us in LATEX.

Once the proposal has been accepted, here is a checklist of everything we require from the volume editor:

1. Preface and organization pages: source and pdf file.
2. Table of contents (incl. topical headings): any type of electronic version
3. Papers: sources (incl. Bbl files and images) and pdf files of each contribution grouped in a directory and correctly labeled.
4. Copyright forms: one for each paper, signed by the corresponding author.
5. A list of the authors' names that are not straight forward (Given Name; Family Name).
6. Title: suggestion for the main title and for the subtitle, where applicable.
7. Conference logo: for inclusion on the cover (where applicable).
8. List of email addresses of corresponding authors: one per paper.
