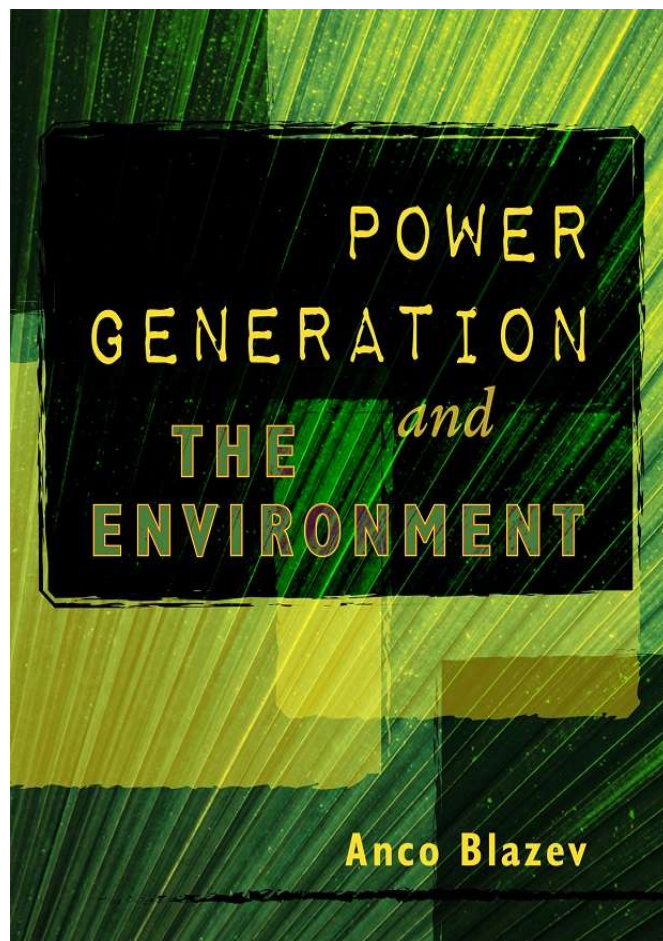


Power Generation and the Environment
